What will I learn?

Students who take this course will gain a broad range of skills including: presenting business documents, learning about how organisations use and exchange information, accessing information on the internet and producing a website, installing, configuring, testing and implementing computer systems, creating and using databases and spreadsheets and programming in Visual Basic.

Where might it lead?

With a Level 3 qualification there are a variety of opportunities, both ICT and non-ICT based, from employment, particularly in local government to further education such as HND degrees. Previous students have entered into areas as diverse as local government, administration posts, programming, computing and ICT and Business degree courses, retail management and public service posts.

What are the entry requirements?

Level level 2 threshold (5 A* - C GCSE passes or equivalent). Students must have studied and ICT qualification at level 2.
