

BTEC NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN PERFORMING ARTS DANCE

Level: 3
BOARD: ECEXCEL
LENGTH OF COURSE: – 2 YEARS

What will I learn?

This course aims to provide a broad educational base for further training, further education and employment within the performing arts sector. The qualifications will develop students abilities through the knowledge and skills gained in areas such as dance performance, choreographing dance, dance appreciation, health and nutrition and performing arts business. There will also be opportunities to train in ballet, tap, jazz and street dance.

How will I learn?

Through practical lessons, workshops, research and self study.

How will I be assessed?

Through tuition, guided learning, personal study, research and practical assignment work.

Where might it lead?

You could take this dance course to complement other training within the Performing Arts field such as Drama or Music with broader subjects as Media, Travel and Tourism, Psychology or Sport. This could lead to further education and training at University in a degree such as Dance Performance or Theatre Dance.

With further training, you could become a teacher of dance within primary, secondary or private education, a professional dancer or freelance choreographer, or train to work in the community.

What are the entry requirements?

Level 2 threshold (5 A* - C GCSE passes or equivalent). Students should have a C or above in GCSE Dance. It is also recommended that students have a C or above in GCSE English Language to help them with written elements of the course.
