

# **BTEC NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN PERFORMING ARTS (Drama)**

Level: 3  
BOARD: ECEXCEL  
LENGTH OF COURSE: – 2 YEARS

## **What will I learn?**

Students will study a number of units, which will provide them with an opportunity to develop an understanding of specific areas of the Performing Arts. This course prepares students to study the Performing Arts at a tertiary level and also given student skills in specific areas which they could pursue as a career path after completing this course.

## **How will I learn?**

Through observation, self study, research and practical work.

## **How will I be assessed?**

Through tuition, guided learning, personal study, research and practical assignment work.

## **Where might it lead?**

This course offers a specialist qualification for entering employment in the performing arts or progressing onto further education such as BTEC Higher Nationals in Performing Arts or related degree programmes. You could also go onto study a relevant NVQ vocational qualification, which could be work-based.

With further training, you could go into a job related to performing arts such as a choreographer or dance teacher.

The course provides a work related programme of study so you could go straight into a job as it helps you develop the skills, understanding and knowledge that many employers are looking for, especially in performing industries such as theatre.

## **What are the entry requirements?**

Level 2 threshold (5 A\* - C GCSE passes or equivalent). BTEC Diploma 2 in Performing Arts is essential.
